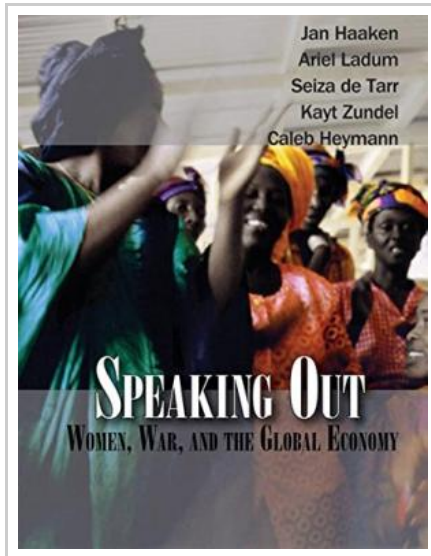




Speaking Out: Women, War and the Global Economy (Paperback)
