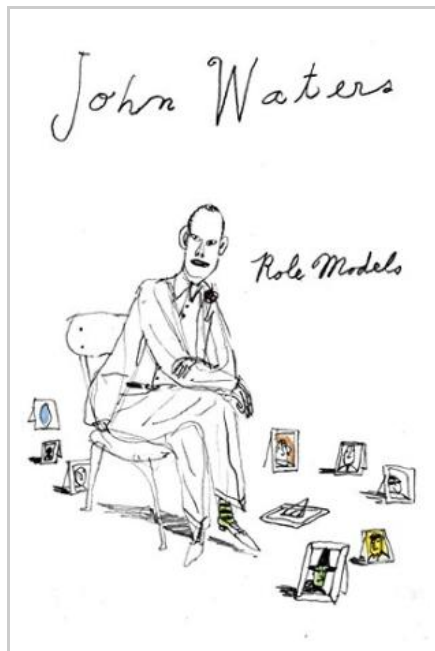




## Role Models
